- Saxon or Norman times by children.(weald)
 - According to the Wisdon which is called the bible of cricket, the cricket was mentioned first time in 1300 A.D.
 - It is verified from the bat and ball, which were found from the almirah of King of Edward.
 - 1611- Cricket being played as an adult sport

Name of "Cricket" :-

- The name may have been derived from the Middle Dutch krick meaning a stick.
- The Old English cricc or cryce meaning a crutch or staff.
- The French word criquet meaning a wooden post
