












- If a thrower's foot touches or crosses the throw line, he receives a foul.
- The thrower's foot cannot go outside the lines of the runway.



 Throwers cannot leave the runway until after the javelin lands.












Throwers cannot turn their backs to the field from the time they get into throwing position until the time of the javelin's release.














> The javelin shall be held at the grip with one hand only.


It shall be thrown over the shoulder or upper part of the throwing arm and shall not be slung or hurled. non-orthodox styles are not permitted.







A throw shall be valid only if the metal head strikes the ground before any other part of the javelin.









If the javelin breaks during a throw or while in the air, it shall not count as a failure, athlete shall be awarded a replacement trial.
 The taping must not assist the athlete and it must be checked

The taping must not assist the athlete and it must be checked by the chief judge prior to start. Taping two or more fingers together is not allowed. The use of gloves is not allowed.











Time allowed-

- One minute is allowed to complete a trial from the time his name is announced.
 A clock showing the remaining time left for a trial should
- be visible to the athlete.

An official shall also raise a yellow flag to indicate during the final 15 seconds of the time allowed.












Distance Measurement

 Distance is measured from the head of the javelin to the inside edge of the arc, along a line to the center of the circle of which the arc is part.









- When the number of athlete more than eight athletes, each athlete shall be allowed three trials and the eight athletes with the best valid performances shall be allowed three additional trials.
- When the number of athlete are eight or less than eight chance will be six time each to them.
